

Brief explanation of what's happening to the user, in a way they can understand without needing a wide knowledge in pharmacology or life sciences in general.

Example: Experiencing **nausea** or **dizziness** this might be caused by the [characteristic of the drug] effect of the [drug full name], which causes [effects on your body] and ends up affecting you this way.

This affects 1 in 10 people – the risk is 10% of higher – the term used is for this side effects is **common**.
